Total destemming. Pre-fermentative Maceration for 2 days. Temperature-controlled fermentation for 2 weeks. Post-fermentative Maceration for 10 days. Aged for 10 months in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES
Red coloured wine with appreciable depth; an aromatic expression of great intensity and balance, boasting fresh fruit, blackberry, blueberry and a whiff of spices; fine, tannic structure, silky and voluminous on the palate, with fruit and tight acidity; delivers an intense and sleek finish.

FOOD PAIRING
Perfectly paired with a barbecue and oven-roasted meats.

REMARKS
Keep the bottle lying at a temperature of 16 °C. Serve at 16 °C.
